## Crime

**1** murder  
every **31** minutes

**1** violent crime  
every **22.4** seconds

**1** aggravated assault  
every **36.8** seconds

**1** property crime  
every **3.2** seconds

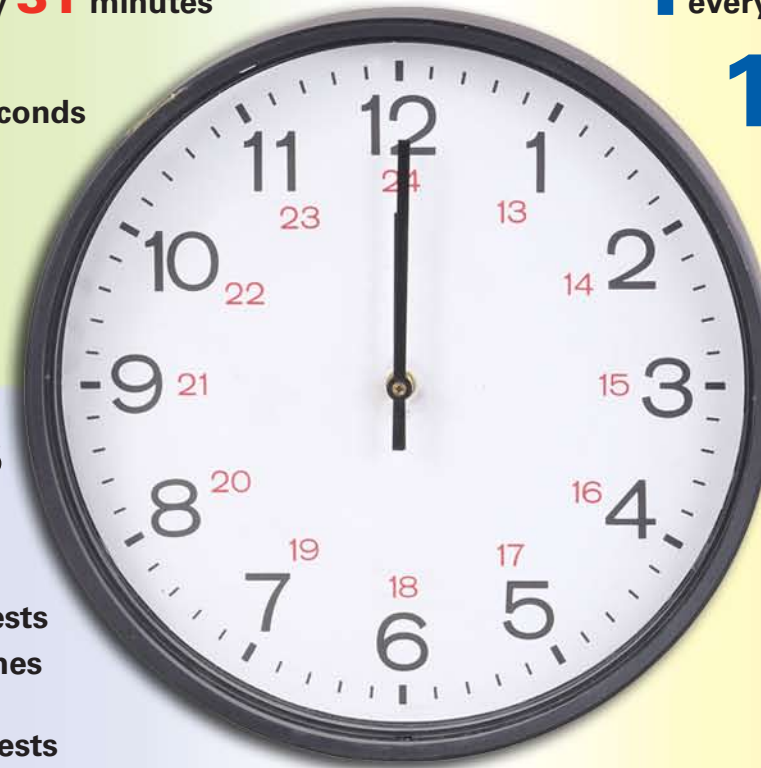
## Crash

**1** traffic fatality  
every **13** minutes

**1** traffic injury  
every **13** seconds

**11** law enforcement reported crashes  
every **1** minute

**1** fatal DUI crash;  
at least one driver has BAC = .08+  
every **45** minutes



## Estimated Arrests

every **1** hour

- 167** DUI arrests
- 51** aggravated assault arrests
- 70** violent crimes arrests
- 14** robbery arrests
- 2** murder arrests
