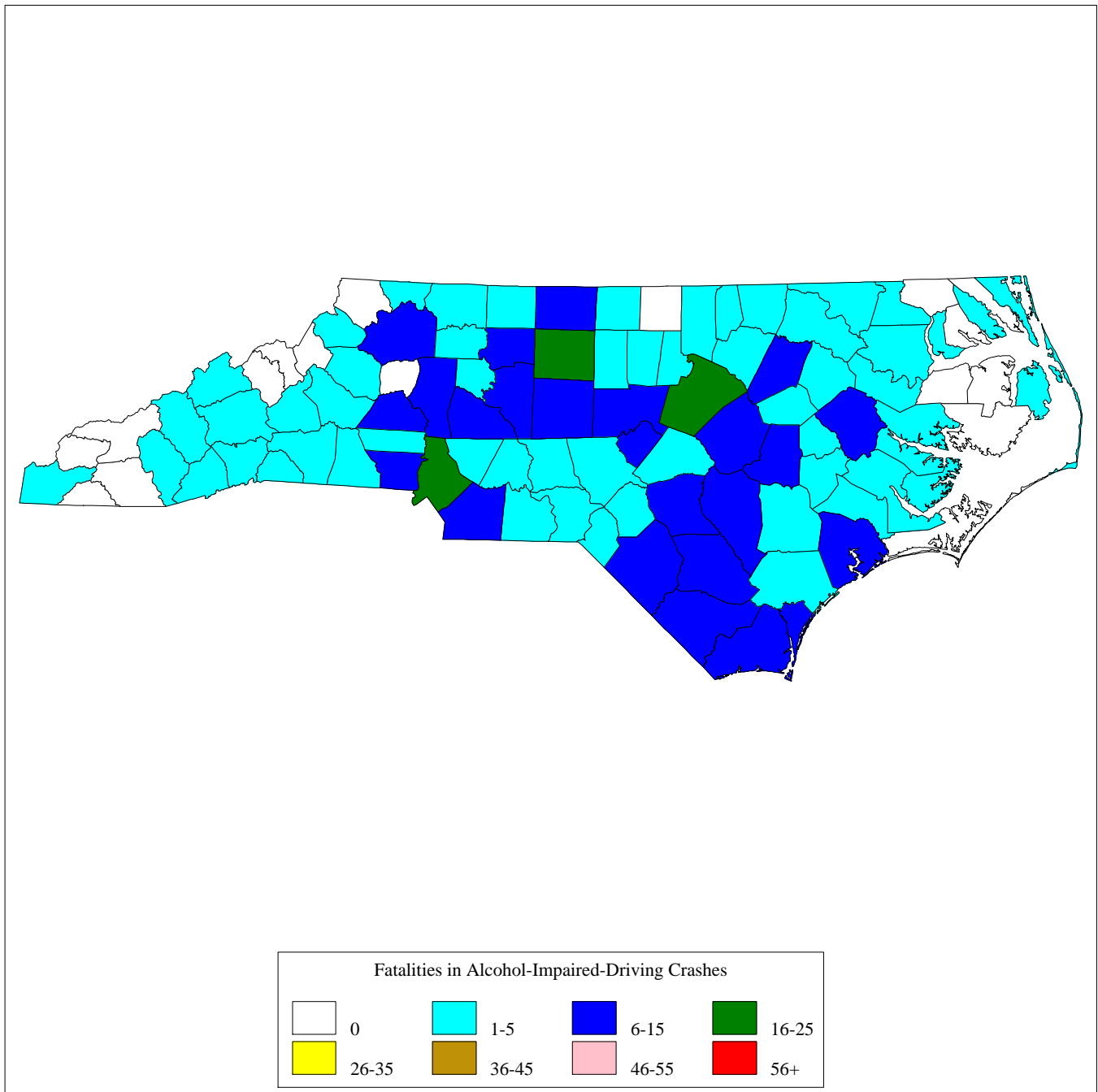




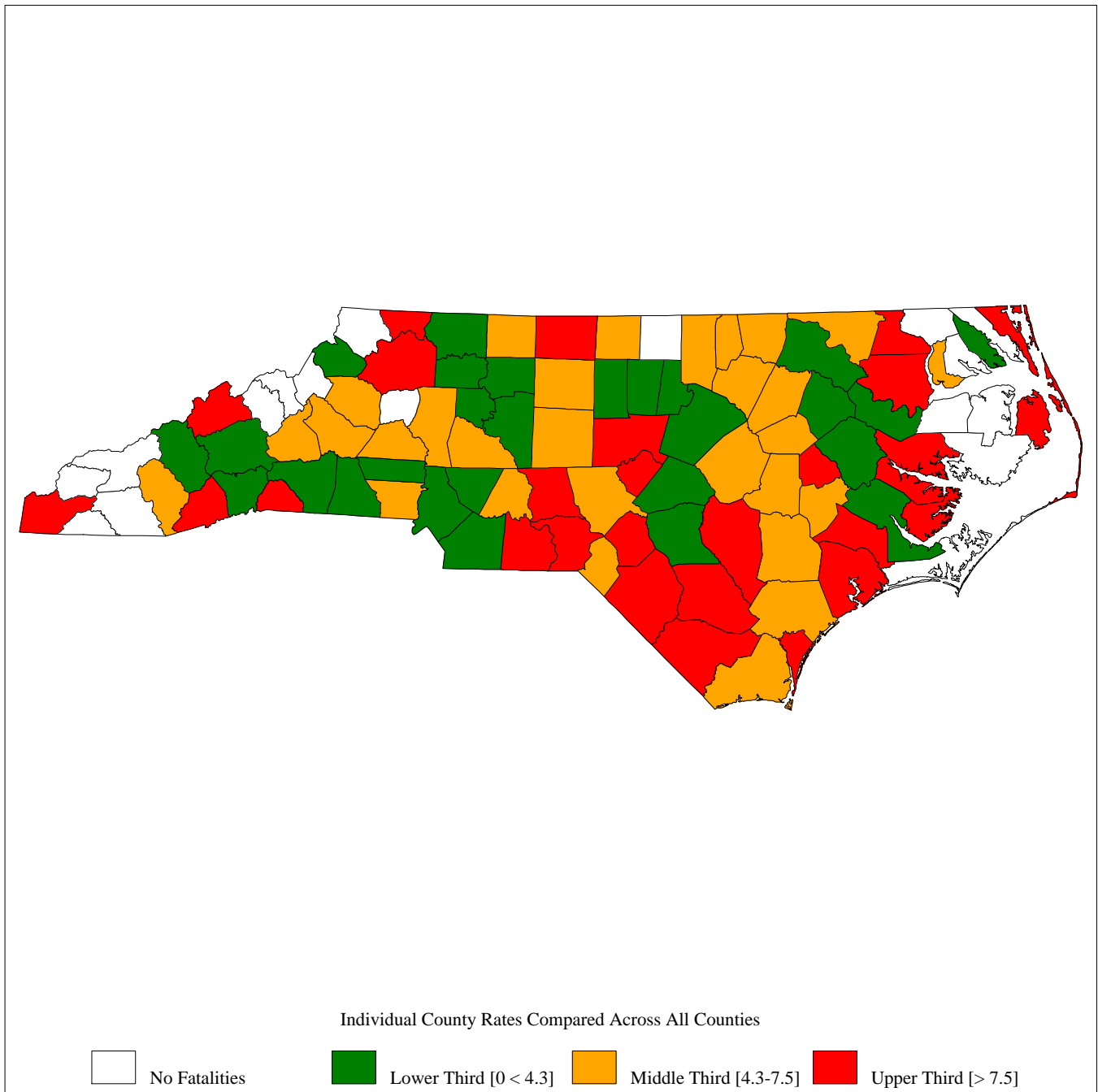


2008 North Carolina Traffic Fatalities in Alcohol-Impaired-Driving Crashes, by County
